gone.

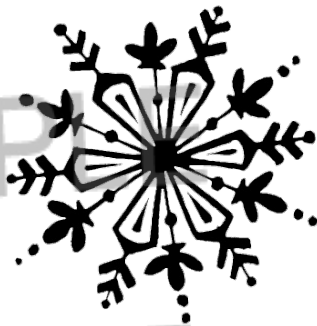
But still we have God's promises, in
